Safari Park Hotel

Safari Park Hotel is a five-star luxury hotel located a 15 minutes drive from the city center of Nairobi. It is a member of the Leading Hotels of the World and stands in 50 acres of beautifully manicured gardens and indigenous forest.



Safari Park Hotel offers a selection of 205 rooms, decorated with a taste of Africa, each with private rear and front balconies. They have en suite marble bathrooms, wooden polished floors, and antique African themed four-poster bed and furniture. Both smoking and non-smoking rooms are available.

Its six excellent restaurants cater to all tastes, including Japanese, Chinese, Indian, Italian, English and African. There is also a casino, several bars, health club, and tennis and squash courts.

Mara Sopa Lodge

Located on the slopes of Oloongams Hills, this is one of the first lodges to be built in the Maasai Mara National Reserve. The accent around the lodge is on the indigenous Maasai people and the fabulous wealth of wildlife, birdlife and natural flora seen in every direction, all within the fabled park lands.

Accommodations are in 50 traditional 'rondavals' or round buildings with thatched roofs, each containing two spacious bedrooms. The large pool has wonderful views and there are evening wildlife films and CNN to enjoy during your down-time.

The dining room and lobby have red painted walls adorned with paintings depicting the Masai going about their every day life. In the centre is a huge fireplace, with life-sized carvings of the Masai and shields. Glass doors open out on to a spacious veranda. There is a jumbo bar in the lounge and another with a billiard table and a viewing deck where at night the hyenas, jackals and wild dogs come out to feed on food remains from the restaurant.

Lake Nakuru Lodge

Situated in the Great Rift Valley, Lake Nakuru Lodge is in the heart of one of Kenya's most densely populated wetland national parks, only two hours' drive from Nairobi through beautiful forested uplands and a series of lakes.



It is in the southeast ecological niche of the



park, with commanding views of the lake. Lush gardens surround the lodge and cottages. The lodge blends in well with its surrounding and animals often browse peacefully close to the lodge and environs, much to the fascination of the visitors. There are accommodations for 180 people and every room has a terrace with a lovely view. The Lodge offers a good program of activities and evening entertainment.

Amboseli Sopa Lodge

Nestled in 190 acres of wooded Maasai land, the lodge sits on the foot hills of Africa's highest mountain, Mt. Kilimanjaro. The lodge is perfectly poised to provide a luxurious base from which to explore the park. It is close to where Ernest Hemingway lived while writing his famous novel, "The Snows of Kilimanjaro".

Each of the 83 rooms, constructed as individual huts, has its own private veranda. The rooms are spacious, with en-suite bathrooms, and the pathways leading to the rooms are sheltered with beautiful plants and trees.



Meals are a cosmopolitan combination of European, African and Asian dishes, all made with fresh produce and served from a colourful buffet. There are also several bars, a great pool and a TV lounge.



Hemingway's Bar, a unique historical structure, has an uninterrupted view of the park. Ernest Hemingway built it as a house and photos of him in his hunting days are hung on the walls. Right at the bottom is a feeding area and water hole which is often frequented by elephants, mongoose and hyenas.

Lake Manyara Serena Lodge

It would be difficult to find a more dramatic setting than the Lake Manyara Serena Lodge. Situated at the edge of an escarpment, this deluxe lodge overlooks both the Great Rift and the beautiful soda lake of Manyara with its lavish supply of birdlife. The birds themselves have provided the inspiration for the lodge's architecture.



The rooms are housed in circular, double-storey, white-washed 'rondavels' (traditional circular buildings with conical thatched roofs), which are strung out along the edge of the cliff so as to allow for maximum views. Each spacious circular room has its own small veranda. Behind each bed hangs a spectacular hand-woven rug, while the furnishings and fittings reflect traditional Maasai beadwork.

The bar and restaurant offer guests both indoor and outdoor seating at each meal. Sumptuous menus, buffets and barbecues are served to guests alongside authentic African dishes.

Serengeti Sopa Lodge

Year-around water and the acacia woodland in this area create an ideal environment for the wide variety of wildlife seen in the immediate vicinity of the Serengeti Sopa Lodge. Being situated on the slopes of the hills, the hotel offers magnificent views over the expanse of the Serengeti National Park, Tanzania's largest wildlife conservation area.



Each of the 69 twin bedrooms are en-suite, with two queen size beds, a small lounge area with mini bar, and a French door leading out onto a balcony that is poised towards a spectacular view of the Serengeti Plains below. Two-million wildebeest make their journey to the Maasai Mara every year less than a kilometre from the Lodge.

The main area provides cool, spacious luxury with high ceiling double-story windows. The prolific wildlife can be observed from elevated dining room, the cocktail bar and lounge and many game viewing terraces. The Lodge also boasts a swimming pool, satellite TV and video.

Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge

The lodge is perched on the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater, a World Heritage Site. It has the most magnificent views over the crater floor, which is home to vast herds of buffalo, wildebeest, zebra, the rare and endangered black rhino, elephant, cheetah, leopard, lion and herds of gazelle and wildebeest.

Its position on the Eastern rim allows spectacular and uninterrupted views of sunset. Another major advantage is that guests can enjoy a safari that begins within five minutes of leaving the lodge, as the park gate is very close.



Each rondavel-style suite has a luxury bathroom, a private lounge with mini-bar, and an enclosed solarium verandah where you have a private view of the crater. The 91 bedrooms are spacious and have two queen-size beds and a separate dressing area.



The food is stylish with international meals and Tanzanian dishes. Temperatures can drop in the evening and the bar area offers a cosy environment with four open fireplaces and comfortable seating, along with a bar, lounge, satellite TV and video. There is a bracing, 'high altitude' swimming pool and gift shop.

Tarangire River Camp

Tarangire River Camp offers an authentic safari experience under traditional canvas showcasing spacious views, enriching culture, and a warm welcome. It is set within 25,000 hectares of concession area and the land overlooks a branch of the Tarangire River. The property is in a great location for game viewing since it is only 3 ½ km. from the main entrance to Tarangire National Park.



Traditional grass thatching adorns the roof of the main lodge structure, which is set off the ground on an elevated deck. The lounge and dining area are in a relaxing open-air environment and the elevated position allows for excellent views over the riverbank below. A game viewing deck also overlooks the stunning views.

Accommodations consist of spacious tents built on wooden platforms with a thatched roof, all of which are en-suite and tastefully furnished with all the comforts you will need while on safari. Each tent's private veranda opens out onto stunning views of Mount Meru and Mount Kilimanjaro in the distant horizon.



The lodge's small, informal gift shop offers the families of the nearby Maasai villages a chance to sell some of their handmade wares.

Serena Mountain Village

Nestled at the foot of the wooded slopes of Mount Meru, this unique hotel stands amid coffee plantations on the shores of tranquil Lake Duluti. It is designed to echo the traditional style of the colonial coffee farm which originally stood on this site.



The main building is designed as a country manor house with a colonial theme, housing the reception, lounge, library, restaurant, shop and business centre. The main lounge and bar area have two fireplaces that make guests feel like they are staying at a home rather than a hotel. There are exquisite pieces of furniture and art work to ensure true authenticity to the colonial theme.

Serena Mountain Village offers stone-built cottages, which are grouped in clusters around a flower-filled central 'village square' set amid extensive landscaped grounds. The rooms and suites feature marble bathrooms, double French doors leading out into the gardens, leaded windows, a stylish work or vanity area, and large and comfortable beds. All the guest rooms have private views that boast magnificent views of the Bougainvillea gardens and the Crater Lake Duluti.



Serena Mountain Village is 20 kilometres from Arusha and 60 kilometres from Kilimanjaro International Airport.
